Each of the four \$1,000 scholarships is a one-time-only grant. All scholarships will be disbursed directly to the student's college and must be used for undergraduate/graduate studies. Scholarship will only be paid in the academic year in which the reward was given out.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All high school seniors who will graduate and college students already enrolled in a graduate or undergraduate program are eligible. Previous winners or employees of Colorado Allergy and Asthma Centers, P.C. and their immediate families are not eligible.

Applicants must:

- Be in good academic standing
- Be a current patient of Colorado Allergy and Asthma Centers, P.C. for a minimum of 1 year
- Be a United States citizen
- Be accepted to an accredited US college

HOW TO APPLY

The applicant, the applicant's physician, and a representative from the applicant's school must complete the application form (or a photocopy of it). Applications must be legible.

Make sure to include additional materials requested for the selection process. All applications must be accompanied by:

- An official academic transcript
- Letter of Support (details provided on form)
- Essay (details provided on form)

Staple all materials together with the application form on top. Mail all materials in one package. Any material that is submitted separately will not be accepted. Incomplete or late applications will NOT be processed, nor will any material be returned.
